(LONDON, UK Wednesday 30 January 2019)

Last year saw the launch of a vibrant new community spirited park event, **Radiate Windrush Festival**. The first outdoor festival in London to shine a spotlight on the Windrush Generations and celebrate the legacy of Black Culture across the Capital. On 22 June 2019 & 23 June 2019 Radiate Windrush Festival takes place on the first official Windrush Day and sets down once again in South London's infamous Crystal Palace Park. The weekend festival highlights the history & social impact of the Windrush Migration, celebrating many generations of Caribbean, African and Creole communities that have blossomed in Britain over the last 70 plus years. In a great outdoor event open for all to attend, the whole family from young to old will be entertained with a variety of activities.

There will be live music & dance performances, DJs, Sound Systems, interactive workshops, culture & history spot, community discussions pods, village stalls, pop-up bookshop, food vendors, interest hubs and a play zone

Radiate Windrush Festival is set to become a well-loved & wonderful addition to the London festival diary for the community. Creating a space filled with love and appreciation it captures the vibrancy of black culture, the complexity of our black communities, the solidarity of the black family and most importantly the deep roots and traditions of generational legacy

Background/ More Info

2018 saw the Windrush Scandal make global headline news. Families were torn apart, relationships were destroyed, livelihoods were lost and even deaths occurred as a result of a targeted attack on the black largely Caribbean community of British Citizens who were not naturalised after the changes to immigration after 1971. Latterly the hostile immigration policies of both the Labour and Conservative governments that followed focused on the vulnerable offspring of the Caribbean community who were now officially classified as undocumented having legally and permissibly travelled to Britain on the documents of their parents and relatives

Leaders of the Caricom States and Labour MPs came together to petition Central Government for answers and changes to the unjust treatment of its country's migrants after many worrying cases of traumatic deportation came to light.

After successfully advocating for the rights of pre-1971 minors of the Windrush generation migrants, an official Windrush Day has been marked and established to be celebrated across the UK.
